

The impact of this funding last year (2016/2017) Newstead

Key Stage 2 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 82% which was 17% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 88% which was 12% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 88% which was 14% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 94% which was 20% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 78% which was 26% above the national average

Key Stage 1 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 63% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 63% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 68% which was broadly in line with the national average

Year 1 Phonics attainment

- disadvantaged pupils achieved 91% which was 25% above the national average

EYFS

- The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 95% compared with 52% nationally
