JOIN OUR ACADEMY – 2019 RECEPTION & NURSERY PLACES



Please note that the system is now open to secure your Reception class place for September 2019. Even if your child is in our nursery now – you still need to apply for their Reception place for next year. If you, or someone you know, would like a Nursery place for September 2019, we will continue to provide full time Nursery, 5 days a week, rather than the standard 15 hours. All applications should be made by visiting:

www.stoke.gov.uk and following the link to School Admissions. Reception applications could be made from November 1st and the closing date is January 15th 2019. Nursery applications can be made from December 3rd and the closing date is January 31st 2019!
