

## **PUPIL PREMIUM IMPACT**



### **The impact of this funding last year (2017/2018) Newstead**

#### **Key Stage 2 Attainment**

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 78% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 72% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 72% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 72% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 72% which was broadly in line with the national average

#### **Key Stage 1 Attainment**

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 88% which was above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 88% which was above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 88% which was above the national average

#### **Year 1 Phonics Attainment**

- disadvantaged pupils achieved 81% which was above the national average

#### **EYFS Attainment**

- The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 83% compared with 52% nationally
